Subject: European Court of Auditors' Special Report No 7/2017: The certification bodies' new role on CAP expenditure: a positive step towards a single audit model but with significant weaknesses to be addressed  
– *Designation of Working Party*

1. On 4 May 2017, the European Court of Auditors' Special Report No 7/2017 entitled "The certification bodies' new role on CAP expenditure: a positive step towards a single audit model but with significant weaknesses to be addressed"<sup>1</sup>.
2. Under the rules laid down in the Council conclusions on improving the examination of special reports drawn up by the Court of Auditors<sup>2</sup>, it is suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee instruct the Working Party on Financial Agricultural Questions to examine the report in accordance with those rules.
