Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 10.4.2017 amending the Annex to Regulation (EU) No 609/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of substances that may be added to processed cerealbased food and baby food and to food for special medical purposes <i>- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act</i>

1. On 10 April 2017, the Commission adopted the Delegated Regulation referred to above¹ and transmitted it to the Council and the European Parliament in accordance with Article 290 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union. The Legal Basis for the Delegated Regulation is Article 16 of Regulation (EU) No 609/2013 on food intended for infants and young children, food for special medical purposes, and total diet replacement for weight control².
2. The Working Party on Foodstuffs was consulted on 19 April 2017³ through an informal written procedure. On 10 May 2017 at the expiry of the deadline of the consultation no delegation had indicated any reasons for the Council to object to the Delegated Regulation.

3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the Delegated Regulation and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the Delegated Regulation will be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 18(5) of Regulation (EU) No 609/2013.
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
