Subject:	Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU) No 531/2012 as regards rules for wholesale roaming markets (First reading)
	- Information from the Presidency on the state of play

- 1. On 15 June 2016, the Commission adopted and transmitted to the Council and to the European Parliament the above-mentioned proposal which regulates the wholesale roaming markets, in view of the introduction on 15 June 2017 of the roam-like-at-home (RLAH) principle foreseen by Regulation (EU) 2015/2120. This initiative should ensure that the level of wholesale roaming charges enables the sustainable provision of RLAH in the Union without distorting the domestic visited and home markets.
- 2. The TTE (Telecom) Council, at its meeting on 2 December 2016, adopted a General Approach which proposed a declining glide-path for data and a wholesale sustainability mechanism. This provided the starting point for negotiations with Parliament which resulted in a final political agreement established with the Parliament on 31 January.
- 3. The text of this Regulation has now been finalised and will be published in the Official Journal of European Union of 9 June. This means that from 15 June the principle of roam-like-at-home will be achieved for our citizens.
