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Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 2.6.2017 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 609/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the specific compositional and information requirements for total diet replacement for weight control  
*- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act*

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1. On 2 June 2017, the Commission notified the European Parliament and the Council of the adoption of the above Delegated Regulation in accordance with Article 18(4) of Regulation (EU) No 609/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council<sup>1</sup>.
2. The Working Party on Foodstuffs considered, through an informal written procedure<sup>2</sup>, that there are no grounds for the Council to object to this delegated act.
3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to:
  - confirm the agreement reached by the Working Party, and
  - recommend to the Council to confirm, as an "A" item on its Agenda, that there are no grounds for objecting the above Commission Delegated Regulation.<sup>3</sup>
