Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 18.5.2017 supplementing Council Regulation (EC) No 207/2009 on the European Union trade mark and repealing Commission Regulations (EC) No 2868/95 and (EC) No 216/96
- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. On 18 May 2017, the Commission submitted the above-mentioned delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 208 of Regulation 2017/1001².
2. No objections were raised by delegations during the silence procedure that expired on 26 June 2017.
3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the above mentioned delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 208 of Regulation 2017/1001.
