The Council held an exchange of views on the latest developments in the global action against climate change. Ministers expressed their views on the unilateral decision of the US administration to withdraw from the Paris Agreement. They reaffirmed their commitments to implement fully the legally-binding agreement and voiced their support for a responsible global leadership of the EU and its Member States. They also welcomed the conclusions adopted on the issue at the Foreign Affairs Council the same day.

= Information from the Presidency

The Council took note of the state of play of the discussions on the waste package. The Presidency briefed the Council about the first trilogue on this legislative package held on 30 May in which the three institutions exchanged views on their overall position on the four proposals. A second trilogue is foreseen on 26 June to continue a detailed examination. Delegations took the floor to welcome the progress made by the Maltese Presidency during this first semester of 2017 and to reiterate their call for setting ambitious and yet realistic waste-management targets.
