Subject:	Proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 16/2017 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2017

1. On 27 June 2017, the Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 16/2017.

The purpose of this proposal is to transfer an amount of EUR 30 million in commitment appropriations (c/a) and an amount of EUR 23 million in payment appropriations (p/a) from Article 40 02 42 (*Emergency aid reserve*) to Article 23 02 01 (*Delivery of rapid, effective and needs-based humanitarian aid and food aid*), as recorded in document 10720/17 FIN 421.

2. The transfer is being proposed in order to provide humanitarian assistance to respond to the increased needs in the crisis in Iraq, for a total amount of EUR 30 million in c/a and EUR 23 million in p/a.
3. The Budget Committee examined this proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 29 June 2017.

4. Following that examination, the Budget Committee agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
- the proposed transfer of appropriations;
 - the draft letter in the ANNEX to that effect.
