Subject: Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No .../...of 19.06.2017 replacing Annex I to Regulation (EC) 1896/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council creating a European order for payment procedure
- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 31 of Regulation (EC) No 1896/2006² of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing a European Small Claims Procedure as amended by Regulation (EU) 2015/2421³. The delegated act is based on Article 30 of that Regulation. The Commission having notified the delegated act to the Council on 19 June 2017, the Council has until 19 August 2017 to object to it.
2. The Working Party on Civil Law Matters (General Questions) has examined the delegated act by written procedure until 30 June 2017 and has concluded that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.

3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies, that unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 31(5) of Regulation (EC) No 1896/2006.
