Subject: Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No .../.. of 23.6.2017 supplementing Directive (EU) 2015/2366 of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to regulatory technical standards for the cooperation and exchange of information between competent authorities relating to the exercise of the right of establishment and the freedom to provide services of payment institutions
= intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. On 23 June 2017, the Commission submitted the above-mentioned delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 11(2) of Regulation 1093/2010 EU².

2. No objections were raised by delegations during the silence procedure expired on 5 July 2017.
 3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 13(2) of Regulation 1093/2010 EU.
