Subject: Commission delegated Regulation (EU) .../... of 31.5.2017 supplementing Directive 2010/40/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the provision of EU-wide multimodal travel information services (Text with EEA relevance)  
- Intention not to raise objection to the delegated act

---

1. 31 May 2017, the Commission submitted the above delegated Regulation to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 6(1) of Directive 2010/40/EU<sup>1</sup>.
2. The deadline for raising objections to the delegated act expires on 31 July 2017.
3. On 13 June 2017, the General Secretariat of the Council informed the delegations about this delegated act<sup>2</sup> and requested their reactions, if any, in writing by 4 July 2017.

4. Following the written consultation, delegations did not provide any indication that there is any reason to raise objections to the delegated act.
5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to recommend to the Council to confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament be informed thereof.
6. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects, the delegated act shall enter into force in accordance with Article 14(2) of Directive 2010/40/EU.
