Subject: Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) .../... amending Regulation (EU)
No 540/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the
Acoustic Vehicle Alerting System requirements for vehicle EU-type
approval
- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with regard to Article 8 and Article 9 of Regulation (EU) No 540/2014² of the European Parliament and of the Council on the sound level of motor vehicles and of replacement silencing systems, and amending Directive 2007/46/EC and repealing Directive 70/157/EEC. The Commission having notified the delegated act to the Council on 26 June 2017, the Council has until 26 August 2017 to object to it.

2. The Working Party on Technical Harmonisation has examined the delegated act by written procedure until 6 July 2017 and has concluded that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.
3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies, that unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 10 of Regulation (EU) No 540/2014.
