Subject: Proposal for a Council Regulation adjusting with effect from 1 July 2013 the correction coefficients applied to the remuneration and pensions of officials and other servants of the European Union
- Decision to use the written procedure for the adoption

1. On 8 November 2013 the Commission transmitted to the Council the proposal for a Council Regulation adjusting with effect from 1 July 2013 the correction coefficients applied to the remuneration and pensions of officials and other servants of the European Union in the various places of employment on the basis of Article 64 of the Staff Regulations. These intra-EU weightings shall be adopted by the Council, acting on a qualified majority on a proposal from the Commission as provided in Article 16(4) and (5) of the Treaty on European Union.
2. Due to the suspension of the application of certain provisions of the amended Staff Regulations¹ for the years 2013 and 2014 pursuant to the new Article 65 of the Staff Regulations, this Commission proposal did not include the annual adjustment to remuneration and pensions, but was limited to the adjustment of the correction coefficients and updating the reference date for the exchange rates.

3. The Working Party on the Staff Regulations examined the proposal at its meeting on 11 November 2013.
4. Given the urgency of a timely adoption of this Council Regulation, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to **endorse the use of the written procedure** for its formal adoption as set out in doc. 15885/13.
