THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 3924/91 of 19 December 1991 on the establishment of a Community survey of industrial production<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 2(6) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Regulation (EEC) No 3924/91 requires Member States to carry out a Community survey of industrial production.
- (2) The survey of industrial production must be based on a list of products identifying the industrial production to be surveyed.
- (3) A list of products is necessary to permit alignment between production statistics and external trade statistics and to afford comparison with the Community product nomenclature CPA.
- (4) The list of products required by Regulation (EEC) No 3924/91, referred to as the "Prodcom list", is common to all Member States, and is necessary in order to compare data across Member States.
- (5) In order to reflect the technological development and structural changes of the industrial production, it is necessary to establish an updated Prodcom list.
- (6) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the European Statistical System Committee,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

The Prodcom list shall be as set out in the Annex.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the twentieth day following that of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

It shall apply from 1 January 2017.
