Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) No .../.. of 14.2.2014 establishing a derogation from Regulation (EU) No 1290/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the rules for participation and dissemination in "Horizon 2020 - the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation (2014-2020)"

- with regard to the Innovative Medicines Initiative 2 Joint Undertaking
- with regard to the ECSEL Joint Undertaking
- with regard to the Bio-Based industries Joint Undertaking
- with regard to the Clean Sky 2 Joint Undertaking
- intention not to raise objections to the delegated acts

1. The Commission submitted the above-mentioned delegated acts¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Articles 1(3) and 56 of the Regulation (EU) No 1290/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 laying down the rules for participation and dissemination in "Horizon 2020 - the Framework Programme for Research and Innovation (2014-2020)"². The Commission notified the above-mentioned delegated acts on 14 February 2014 and therefore the Council has the possibility to object to them until 14 April 2014.
2. The Research Working Party examined the delegated acts at its meeting of 3 March 2014 and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to them.
3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated acts in question and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to them, the delegated acts shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Articles 1(3) and 56 of Regulation (EU) No 1290/2013.
