Subject: COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) .../... of XXX amending Annexes I and III to Regulation (EC) No 999/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards a surveillance programme for chronic wasting disease in cervids in Estonia, Finland, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland and Sweden and repealing Commission Decision 2007/182/EC
- Decision not to oppose the adoption

1. On 17 July 2017, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and the Council the above draft Regulation (ST 11367/2017 + ADD 1), in accordance with Article 5 bis (3)(a) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC, as modified by Council Decision No 2006/512/EC laying down the procedures for the exercise of implementing powers conferred on the Commission.
2. The Working Party of Agricultural Counsellors considered through an informal written procedure (WK 8285/2017), that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
