Dear Sir/Madam,

I refer to the adoption of the following legal act by the European Parliament and the Council: REGULATION (EU) No 1077/2011 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 25 October 2011 establishing a European Agency for the operational management of large-scale IT systems in the area of freedom, security and justice.

On behalf of the Government of Norway, I hereby formally notify that Norway has fulfilled constitutional requirements according to Article 8 paragraph 2 (c) of the Agreement concerning the Republic of Iceland's and the Kingdom of Norway's association with the implementation, application and development of the Schengen acquis, and accepts the content of the said act.

In accordance with Article 37 of regulation (EU) No. 1077/2011, the detailed rules for the participation of Norway in the Agency shall be set out in an "Arrangement between the EU, of the one part, and the Kingdom of Norway, the Republic of Iceland, the Swiss Confederation and the Principality of Lichtenstein, of the other part, on the participation by those States in the European Agency for the operational management of large-scale IT systems in the area of freedom, security and justice".

The Government of Norway notes that the full application of regulation (EU) No. 1077/2011 can only take effect once the said Arrangement enters into force.
