Dear Secretary-General,

I have the honor to inform you of the Hellenic Government's Decision to appoint Mr Panagiotis MANIATIS as Deputy National Member for Greece in Eurojust.

Mr. Panagiotis Maniatis is a Deputy Public Prosecutor at the Public Prosecutor's Office of First Instance of Athens. He joined the Public Prosecution Service in 2005. He was an attorney and a member of the Athens Bar Association between 1998 and 2004. He holds two postgraduate degrees ("D.E.S. in European and International Law" and "Master's Degree in Criminal Law, Criminal Procedural Law and Criminology").

He is the Greek national member in the Council of Europe Committee of Experts on the operation of C.o.E. Conventions on cooperation in criminal matters (PC-OC) and in the South East European Prosecutors Advisory Group (SEEPAG). Between 2012 and 2015 he has been the national Maritime Piracy Prosecutor. His expertise focuses mainly on the areas of corruption, money laundering, international terrorism and transport related terrorism offences, cybercrime, cigarette smuggling, counterfeited pharmaceutical products, crimes against intellectual property, mechanisms of international judicial cooperation and international protection of human rights.
