Subject:	COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) .../... of XXX amending Annex I to Directive 2002/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards maximum levels for lead, mercury, melamine and decoquinate <i>- Decision not to oppose the adoption</i>

1. On 21 August 2017, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and the Council the above draft Regulation (ST 11730/17 + ADD 1), in accordance with Article 5 bis (3)(a) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC, as modified by Council Decision No 2006/512/EC laying down the procedures for the exercise of implementing powers conferred on the Commission.
2. The Working Party of Agricultural Counsellors considered through an informal written procedure (WK 8758/2017), that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
