Subject: National expert's change of role at the Austrian Eurojust desk

---

The Federal Ministry of Justice is pleased to announce that in accordance with Article 30(2) of the Council Decision of 28 February 2002 setting up Eurojust with a view to reinforcing the fight against serious crime (OJ L 63, 6.3.2002, p. 1, as amended by the Council Decision of 16 December 2008, OJ L 138, 4.6.2009, p. 14), Mr Michael SCHMID, public prosecutor at the Vienna Public Prosecutor's Office, will cease to act as seconded national expert (SNE) on 31 August 2017 and will now act as

**deputy to Austria's national member**

**from 1 September 2017 to 31 August 2019**

in place of Dr Reinhard SANTELER, LL.M., public prosecutor.

The powers of the deputy national member are governed by sections 63 and 64 of Austria's Federal Act on judicial cooperation in criminal matters with the Member States of the European Union (Federal Law Gazette I no 36/2004).
