Subject: Commission delegated regulation No. xxx/17 on the conditions for
classification, without testing, of cross laminated timber products covered
by the harmonised standard EN 16351 and laminated veneer lumber
products covered by the harmonised standard EN 14374 with regard to
their reaction to fire
- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 60 (g) of Regulation (EU) No 305/2011² laying down harmonised conditions for the marketing of construction products and repealing Council Directive 89/106/EEC. The delegated act is based on Article 27 (5) of that Regulation. The Commission having notified the delegated act to the Council on 21 August 2017, the Council has until 21 November 2017 to object to it.

2. The Working Party on Technical Harmonisation has examined the delegated act by written procedure until 22 September 2017 and has concluded that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.
3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies, that unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 60 of Regulation (EU) No 305/2011.
