Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED DECISION of 11.9.2017 amending Annex V  
to Directive 2005/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as  
regards evidence of formal qualifications and the titles of training courses  
- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

---

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act<sup>1</sup> to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU to amend Annex V to Directive 2005/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards evidence of formal qualifications and the titles of training courses. The proposed measure is based on Article 21a(4) of Directive 2005/36/EC, as amended, which authorises the Commission to adopt delegated acts in accordance with Article 57c of that Directive to amend points 5.1.1 to 5.1.4, 5.2.2, 5.3.2, 5.3.3, 5.4.2, 5.5.2, 5.6.2 and 5.7.1 in Annex V.

2. Having been notified by the Commission of the delegated act on 11 September 2017, delegations were invited to react by 6 October 2017.
  3. No objections by Member States have been received by this deadline.
  4. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee confirms to the Council that it has no intention of objecting to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 58 of Directive (EC) 2005/36/EC.
