### 1. Adoption of the agenda

The agenda as set out in [CM 3856/17](#) was adopted without amendments.

### 2. Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the establishment, operation and use of the Schengen Information System (SIS) in the field of police cooperation and judicial cooperation in criminal matters, amending Regulation (EU) No [515/2014](#) and repealing Regulation (EC) No [1986/2006](#), Council Decision [2007/533/JHA](#) and Commission Decision [2010/261/EU](#)

On the basis of a revised draft compromise text submitted by the Presidency, as set out in [9594/1/17 REV 1](#), the Working Party (WP) held a third round of discussions on the remaining open articles of the proposal: Articles 53, 56, 57, 58, 59, 62, 64, 65, 66, 71, 72. The articles which are not mentioned had been already agreed on by the WP in previous meetings.

During this meeting, the WP reached an agreement on Articles 57, 59, 71 and 72.

The Presidency informed the WP that a document would be prepared for the next meeting with the articles which had not yet been agreed on by the WP (12459/17). That document took into account the discussions previously held regarding the open articles and the written comments which the Presidency asked delegations to send to [schengenacquis@consilium.europa.eu](mailto:schengenacquis@consilium.europa.eu) and [schacquis@list.politsei.ee](mailto:schacquis@list.politsei.ee).

BG and PT lifted their reservations on this proposal. General scrutiny reservations were still pending from AT, CZ, DE, FI, HU, IT, NL, PL, SE, SI and UK. A parliamentary reservation was still pending from UK.

**3. Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the establishment, operation and use of the Schengen Information System (SIS) in the field of border checks, amending Regulation (EU) No 515/2014 and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1987/2006**

On the basis of a revised draft compromise text submitted by the Presidency, as set out in 9593/1/17 REV 1, the WP held a third round of discussions on the proposal. During this meeting, the WP reached an agreement on Articles 9, 10, 11, 15, 16, 20, 23, 24, 24A, 25, 30, 32A, 32B, 35, 39, 40, 41, 42, 46, 47, 54, 55 and 58. The articles which are not mentioned had been already agreed on by the WP in previous meetings.

The Presidency informed the WP that a document would be prepared for the next meeting with the articles which had not yet been agreed on by the WP (12459/17). That document took into account the discussions previously held regarding the open articles and the written comments which the Presidency asked the delegations to send to [schengenacquis@consilium.europa.eu](mailto:schengenacquis@consilium.europa.eu) and [schacquis@list.politsei.ee](mailto:schacquis@list.politsei.ee).

BG and PT lifted their reservations on this proposal. General scrutiny reservations were still pending from AT, CZ, DE, FI, HU, IT, NL, PL, SE and SI. A parliamentary reservation from DE was still pending.

#### **4. Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on use of the Schengen Information System for the return of illegally staying third-country nationals**

On the basis of a revised draft compromise text submitted by the Presidency, as set out in 9592/1/17 REV 1, the Working Party (WP) held a third round of discussions on the proposal. The WP discussed at length the text submitted by the Presidency and some progress was achieved.

The Presidency informed the WP that a document would be prepared for the next meeting (12605/17). That document took into account the discussions previously held regarding the articles and the written comments which the Presidency asked delegations to send to [schengenacquis@consilium.europa.eu](mailto:schengenacquis@consilium.europa.eu) and [schacquis@list.politsei.ee](mailto:schacquis@list.politsei.ee). The document to be issued would also include all the recitals of the original Commission proposal, as set out in 15812/17, that the Presidency intended to be examined by the WP.
