Subject:	Draft Council Implementing Decision setting out a recommendation on addressing the deficiencies identified in the 2016 evaluation of Austria on the application of the Schengen acquis in the field of temporary reintroduction of border control at the internal border with Hungary and absence of border control at the internal border with Italy

1. Following the Council's adoption of Regulation (EU) No 1053/2013 establishing an evaluation and monitoring mechanism to verify the application of the Schengen acquis, a team of experts from the Member States and the Commission carried out an evaluation of Austria on the application of the Schengen acquis in the field of temporary reintroduction of border control at the internal border with Hungary and absence of border control at the internal border with Italy, in 2016.
2. In accordance with that Regulation, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Implementing Decision setting out a Recommendation designed to address the deficiencies identified in the course of the evaluation and ensure that Austria applies all Schengen rules related to the temporary reintroduction of border control at the internal border with Hungary and absence of border control at the internal border with Italy correctly and effectively.

3. The Working Party for Schengen Matters (Evaluation), including the Mixed Committee partners Norway, Iceland, Switzerland and Liechtenstein, approved the proposal for the Council Implementing Decision setting out a Recommendation on 4 October 2017.

4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to recommend that the Council adopt the draft Council Implementing Decision, as set out in 13367/17, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
