## Introduction:

The reinforcement of EUR 2 700 000 in commitment and payment appropriations for the Emergency measures related to animal and plant health will support the efforts made by Member States to contain the spread of the Avian Influenza virus across the EU. The sources of reinforcement are the Union Civil Protection Mechanism, and the support expenditure for Emergency Support Instrument.

#### d) Detailed grounds for the transfer

The Avian Influenza virus has been identified in wild birds and/or poultry farms in 19 Member States so far. While the virus is primarily a bird disease, it could mutate into a strain transmissible from human to human. The Commission supports emergency measures put in place by Member States to contain its spread. Given the magnitude of the crisis, total financial support is expected to go over and beyond EUR 100 million for emergency measures implemented by the Member States in 2016-2017, with payments by the EU to Member States spread over the period 2017-2019. There is significant intervention in particular in France, Germany, Hungary, Poland, Italy, Sweden and Bulgaria. In the absence of a reserve crisis, appropriations on this budget line for emergency measures are insufficient.

The Commission launched the payment of an advance of 35% of the expected amount of EU contribution to 16 affected Member States in September 2017; the advance comes up to an amount of EUR 36 million, which represents a significant burden to the 2017 Food and Feed budget. Additional resources have been identified through internal redeployment within the food chain measures (an amount of EUR 22 million has already been transferred internally). The proposed increase in the commitment and payment appropriations for the budget line 17 04 04 will allow paying an additional advance to Member States for this Avian Influenza crisis still in 2017.
