The Presidency intends organising a meeting of the Working Party on Cooperation in Criminal Matters (COPEN) on Monday 18 December 2017. Issues on the provisional agenda include a discussion on the (application of) case-law of the CJEU (including the judgments in case C-640/15, Vilkas, in case C-579/15, Poplawki, and in cases C-271/17 and C-270/17, Zdziaszek/Tupikas), the implementation of Directive 2014/41/EU on the European Investigation Order, and the presentation of reports of the genocide network.
