Subject: Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers
Appointment of Ms Madeleine ÖHBERG, member for Sweden, in place of
Ms Sara ANDEGIORGIS, who has resigned

1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Ms Sara ANDEGIORGIS as member of the above Committee in the governments' representatives category (for Sweden).
2. Under Article 24 of Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union², and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof.

Whereas:

- (1) In its Decisions of 20 September 2016³, 14 November 2016⁴ and 28 November 2016⁵, the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 24 September 2018.
- (2) A seat as member in the governments' representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Ms Sara ANDEGIORGIS.
- (3) The Government of Sweden has submitted a nomination for the vacant seat,
