1. Article 10(9)(d) of Council Decision 2005/681/JHA of 20 September 2005 establishing the European Police College (CEPOL) and repealing Decision 2000/820/JHA<sup>1</sup>, reads:

The Governing Board shall adopt *"the work programme, after having consulted the Commission, to be submitted to the Council for approval."*

2. The CEPOL Work Programme 2014 was adopted by the Governing Board by written procedure on 16 December 2013. The Commission adopted its opinion on 13 February 2014.
