– *Orientation debate*

The SCA took note of the contributions made by delegations, the Council Legal Service and the Commission representative on the topics outlined in document 7674/14. The SCA confirmed the text of Articles 2, 3, 4 and 5 in the new drafting thereof. The Presidency concluded that all the remaining provisions, except point (d) of Article 7, were closed but that, however, those delegations who had a point of major importance to them to make would be able to do so in the SCA on 24 March 2014. The Presidency undertook to provide delegations, after the vote of the European Parliament's Committee on Agriculture and Rural Development scheduled for Tuesday 18 March 2014, with a new compromise text on the issues to be discussed by the Council, namely national co-financing and the selection procedure for simple programmes.

4. **Organisation of future work**

The Presidency informed the SCA on its next meeting on Monday 24, in parallel with the Council meeting. Only promotion measures will be on the agenda of SCA.

The "Agriculture and Fisheries" Council will start at 10 o'clock (and not at 9 o'clock as previously mentioned). Several delegations questioned the Presidency about its intentions concerning the future handling of the situation in the dairy sector.
