#### **"I/A" ITEM NOTE**

**Subject:** COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) No .../.. of 7.3.2014 supplementing Directive 2003/71/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to regulatory technical standards for publication of supplements to the prospectus  
- Intention not to raise objections to delegated acts

---

1. On 7 March 2014 the Commission submitted the abovementioned regulatory technical standards, in the form of a delegated act, to the Council in accordance with Directive 2003/71/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 November 2003 on the prospectus to be published when securities are offered to the public or admitted to trading and amending Directive 2001/34/EC<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 16(3).
2. According to the second sub-paragraph of Article 13(1) of Regulation (EU) No 1095/2010, where the Commission adopts a regulatory technical standard which is the same as the draft regulatory technical standard submitted by the Authority, the Council could object within a period of one month.

3. Since adoption by the Commission of the abovementioned regulatory technical standard, in the form of a delegated act, no delegation indicated an intention to object.
  4. It is therefore suggested that the Committee of Permanent Representatives (Part 2) recommend that the Council confirm its intention not to raise objections to this delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are informed thereof.
