We have registered your request of 6 March 2014 for access to documents 6737/14 and 7158/14. Thank you for your interest.

The General Secretariat of the Council has examined your request on the basis of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents¹ (hereafter the "Regulation") and specific provisions of the Council's Rules of Procedure² and has come to the following conclusion:

Documents 6737/14 and 7158/14 are a notes from the Political and Security Committee to COREPER/Council dated respectively 20 February and 3 march 2014. They contain draft texts of the Council conclusions on Ukraine. They are preliminary texts of the Council conclusions drawn up in view of internal deliberations and discussions within the Council.

The draft conclusions proposed in the documents do not correspond to the agreed conclusions published in Council website. The General Secretariat considers that release of these preliminary texts would not only undermine relations between the European Union and Ukraine, but would also prejudice the institution's decision-making process.

Accordingly, pursuant to the third indent of Article 4(1)(a) of the Regulation (protection of the public interest with regard to international relations), and in the absence of any evidence of an overriding public interest in release also pursuant to the second subparagraph of Article 4(3) of the Regulation (protection of the decision-making process of the Council), the General Secretariat is unable to grant you access to these documents.
