Subject: Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No .../.. of 7.3.2014 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the rules for the renewal of authorisations of biocidal products subject to mutual recognition
- Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and in the first paragraph of Article 40 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products². The Commission having notified the delegated act on 10 March 2014, the Council may object to it until 10 May 2014.

2. The Working Party on Environment has examined the delegated act and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object it.

 3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the twentieth day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 9 of the Delegated Regulation.
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
