**Subject:** Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No .../.. of 12.3.2014 establishing substantive requirements for a Union inventory system and taking into account changes in the global warming potentials and internationally agreed inventory guidelines pursuant to Regulation (EU) No 525/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council

- Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

---

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act <sup>1</sup> to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 6(2) and Article 7(6)(b) of Regulation (EU) No 525/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 May 2013 on a mechanism for monitoring and reporting greenhouse gas emissions and for reporting other

information at national and Union level relevant to climate change and repealing Decision No 280/2004/EC<sup>2</sup>. The Commission having notified the delegated act on 12 March 2014, the Council may object to it until 12 May 2014.

2. The Working Party on Environment has examined the delegated act and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object it.
3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the twentieth day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 8 of the Delegated Regulation.
