	- Adoption of Council Decision

- 1. <u>The Commission</u> submitted the above proposal to the Council on 3 February 2014<sup>1</sup>.
- 2. The Working Party on External Fisheries policy examined the proposal on 18 March, 24 and 30 April 2014 and reached an agreement on the text on the basis of a draft Council Decision including negotiating directives<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. <u>The Netherlands, Swedish and United Kingdom delegations</u> entered scrutiny reserves on the text, notably in relation to point a) under principles in the Annex I.

  - decides not to publish the Decision in accordance with Article 17(2)(b) of its Rules of Procedure
  - notes that the European Parliament will be informed in accordance with Article 218(10)
     TFEU, and therefore a paper copy of the Decision including the negotiating directives will be transmitted to the Parliament;
  - enters the statement in the addendum to this note in the minutes of the Council.
