By application notified to the Council on 15 April 2014, the applicants (Chinese producers of solar panels) have brought an action pursuant to Article 263 TFEU for the annulment of Council Implementing Regulation 1239/2013 of 2 December 2013 imposing a definitive countervailing duty on imports of crystalline silicon photovoltaic modules and key components (i.e. cells) originating in or consigned from the People's Republic of China.<sup>1</sup>;
