Subject:	Seventh round of mutual evaluations - Order of visits and observers

In line with Article 2 of the Joint Action 97/827/JHA of 5 December 1997, GENVAL decided at its meeting of 3 October 2013 that the seventh round of mutual evaluations will be devoted to the practical implementation and operation of the European policies on prevention and combating cybercrime. The questionnaire which will serve as a basis for the evaluation is set out in doc. 5335/1/14 REV 1.

Delegations will find in the Annex the order of visits to the Member States during the seventh round, as agreed at the meeting of GENVAL on 1 April 2014.

Delegations also agreed that given their respective fields of expertise the Commission, Eurojust, Europol/European Cybercrime Centre and ENISA should be invited to participate in the onsite visits as observers.

The evaluation teams, will as usual consist of three national experts, supported by two members of the staff of the General Secretariat of the Council and observers.
