Subject:	Appointment of the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work for Lithuania

---

1. The Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work, by its Decision of 22 April 2013<sup>1</sup>. However, it remained to appoint certain members and alternate members at a later stage.
2. Pursuant to Articles 3 and 4 of the Council Decision 2003/C 218/01 of 22 July 2003 on the setting up of an Advisory Committee on Safety and health at Work, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council for a period of three years.
3. Lists of nominations of full and alternate members of the renewed Advisory Committee have been received by the Council Secretariat, as set out in the draft Council Decision in doc. 8749/14<sup>2</sup>.
