- State of play

The Council took note of interventions by the Commission and by delegations, welcomed the mandate given to the Presidency to enter into trilogue negotiations and confirmed its willingness to seek an agreement with the European Parliament, with a view to allowing the Regulation on financial responsibility linked to investor-state dispute settlement to enter into force as soon as possible.
