1. On 12 May 2014, the European Court of Auditors submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No V/AB-03/C/14.

The purpose of this proposal is to transfer an amount of EUR 100000 from Sub-Item 2007-01 (Fitting -out of premises) to Sub-Item 2320-02 (Damages and interest) and EUR 65000 from Sub-Item 2741-01 (Publications) to Sub-Item 2320-01 (Legal expenses).

2 The transfer is being proposed in order to cover the legal costs related to the implementation of a judgement of the Civil Service Tribunal, as well as to ensure provisions for the upcoming decisions of the Tribunal.
3. The Budget Committee examined this proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 3 June 2014.
4. Following that examination, the Budget Committee agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:

- the proposed transfer of appropriations;
- the draft letter in the ANNEX to that effect.
