<u>The SCA</u> took note of the requests of the Austrian, French and Spanish delegations. The <u>SCA</u> also took note of the comments made by delegations, as well as of the reaction from the Commission's representative.

<u>The SCA</u> noted the Presidency's intention to return to this issue at its next meeting on the basis of a draft text for Council conclusions on the future of the dairy sector.

# 6. Recommendation for a Council Decision authorising the opening of negotiations on agreements between the European Union and third countries on trade in organic products

- Examination of the draft Council Decision 8122/14 AGRI 250 AGRILEG 76 + ADD 1 **RESTREINT UE** 

The Presidency gave the delegations another opportunity to express their views on the draft Council Decision authorising the Commission to open negotiations on agreements between the EU and Third countries on trade in organic products. It was agreed that a reference to the SCA would be inserted in Article 3. Some delegations requested the possibility to review this mandate once the current revision of the legislation on organic farming would be terminated and also to inform the Council of the opening of negotiations. Several delegations wished to introduce a revision clause. Therefore, the Presidency presented two amendments to the draft directives\*. The Presidency indicated the date of Thursday 5 (noon) as deadline for the silent procedure and proposed to forward the draft for adoption under an A item procedure at the forthcoming "Agriculture and Fisheries" Council.

### \*Amendments proposed by the PRES:

- 11. The Commission shall return to the Council in order to get new directives if and when a new legislation on organic farming has been adopted and in any case no later than [three] years after the adoption of the Council Decision authorising the opening of negotiations on agreements between the European Union and third countries on trade in organic products.
- 12. Before initiating negotiations with a third country the Commission shall inform the Special Committee referred to in the above Decision.

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# 7. Report from the Commission to the European Parliament and to the Council on the case for a local farming and direct sales labelling scheme

The Presidency gave the delegations a further opportunity to exchange views on this dossier in light of a Presidency non-paper which analysed the three possible options for handling it ((1)stand-alone labelling scheme, (2)optional quality term, or (3)status quo). Delegations were divided. Some of them were in favour of option 2 while many others were in favour of maintaining the status quo (option 3). The Presidency concluded that a majority of delegations would prefer maintaining the status quo, and therefore the SCA should not encourage the Commission to develop a new certification scheme to promote local farming and direct sales at EU level.

## 8. Report from the Commission to the European Parliament and to the Council on the case for an optional quality term "product of island farming"
