Subject: Summary of discussions

1. Adoption of the agenda

The meeting adopted the agenda as set out in doc. CM 2393/14.

2. Proposal for a Regulation on the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Cooperation and Training (Europol) and repealing Decisions 2009/371/JHA and 2005/681/JHA

- Discussion on the recitals and other outstanding issues (Chapter by Chapter)

Before starting examining the Presidency compromise text, some delegations underlined the need to ensure that the provisions of the draft Europol and Eurojust Regulations are consistent, in particular in relation to the data protection, and suggested to continue technical and/or horizontal discussions on this subject.

The Chair noted the concerns of delegations and suggested that the ongoing discussions on other related files should not delay the negotiations on the draft Europol Regulation.

The meeting then examined the full Presidency compromise text of the draft Europol Regulation, including the recitals, as set out in doc. 8596/14 ENFOPOL 101 CODEC 1016 CSC 82, based on the outcome of previous discussions on all the Chapters by the LEWP.

Delegations focused on outstanding issues and made drafting suggestions on certain provisions. Some delegations lifted or entered reservations in relation to parts of the compromise text.

The Chair took note of delegations' reservations and comments and informed them that on that basis the revised compromise text would be prepared for the discussion at COREPER with the aim to reach the general approach at the Council meeting on 5-6 June 2014.
