Subject: Proposal for a Council Directive laying down basic safety standards for protection against the dangers arising from exposure to ionising radiation  
- Adoption

1. The Commission forwarded the above proposal to the Council on 31 May 2012, based on Articles 31 and 32 of the Euratom Treaty.
2. Following several rounds of examination of the proposal, the Working Party on Atomic Questions reached agreement on the text of this Directive. This text has now been finalised by legal linguists as set out in doc. 13675/13.
3. Coreper could therefore invite the Council to adopt the text as set out in doc. 13675/13 as an "A" item.
