Subject:	Appointment of members and alternate members of the Governing Board of the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions for Hungary

- The Governing Board is established by Council Regulation (EC) No 1111/2005 of 24 June 2005¹, amending Regulation (EEC) No 1365/75 on the creation of a European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Condition².
- Pursuant to Article 6 of the Regulation, the members and alternate members of the Governing Board representing the Governments of the Member States, employees' organisations and employers' organisations are appointed by the Council for a period of three years.

- 3. The Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Governing Board of the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions, by its Decision of 2 December 2013³. However, it remained to appoint certain members and alternate members at a later stage.
- Further nominations of a member and an alternate member of the new Governing Board have now been received by the Council Secretariat, as set out in the draft Council Decision in doc. 11259/14⁴.
- 5. The Permanent Representatives Committee could therefore suggest that the Council:
 - (a) adopt the Council Decision appointing a member and an alternate member of the Governing Board of the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions for Hungary, as an "A" item, and
 - (b) decide to publish the Decision for information in the Official Journal of the European Union.
