- Case T-348/14 Oleksandr Viktorovych Yanukovych / Council

---

1. By application notified to the Council on 20 June 2014, the Applicant brought an action pursuant to Articles 263 and 275 TFEU to annul Council Decision 2014/119/CFSP of 5 March 2014, as amended by Council Implementing Decision 2014/216/CFSP of 14 April 2014, and Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 208/2014 of 5 March 2014, as amended by Council Regulation (EU) No 381/2014 of 14 April 2014 implementing Regulation No 208/2014, concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies in view of the situation in Ukraine, insofar as they apply to the Applicant.
2. The applicant invokes the following grounds in support of his claim for annulment of the contested Legal acts:
  - a) Lack of Legal Basis
  - b) Misuse of Power
  - c) Failure to State Reasons

- d) Failure to Fulfil Criteria for Inclusion
  - e) Manifest Error of Assessment
  - f) Breach of Defence Rights/ Effective Judicial Protection
  - g) Breach of Right to Property
3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Ms. Emer FINNEGAN and Mr Jan-Peter HIX, legal advisors in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
