- By application notified to the Council on 20 June 2014, the Applicant brought an action 1. pursuant to Articles 263 and 275 TFEU to annul Council Decision 2014/119/CFSP of 5 March 2014, as amended by Council Implementing Decision 2014/216/CFSP of 14 April 2014, and Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 208/2014 of 5 March 2014, as amended by Council Regulation (EU) No 381/2014 of 14 April 2014 implementing Regulation No 208/2014, concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies in view of the situation in Ukraine, insofar as they apply to the Applicant.
- 2. The applicant invokes the following grounds in support of his claim for annulment of the contested Legal acts:
  - Lack of Legal Basis a)
  - Misuse of Power b)
  - Failure to State Reasons c)
  - d) Failure to Fulfil Criteria for Inclusion

- e) Manifest Errors of Assessment
- f) Breach of Rights of Defence / Effective Judicial Protection
- g) Breach of Right to Property
