Subject: Case before the General Court of the EU  
- Case T-418/14 (Sina Bank v. Council)

---

1. By application notified to the Council on 26 June 2014, Sina Bank has brought an action pursuant to Articles 263 and 275 TFEU for the annulment of:
  - the Council's decision after review contained in the Notice of 15 March 2014 for the attention of the persons and entities subject to the restrictive measures provided for in Council Decision 2010/413/CSFP and in Council Regulation (EV) N°267/2012 concerning restrictive measures against Iran which states that Council Decision 2010/413/CSFP and Council Regulation (EU) N°267/2012 continue to affect directly Sina Bank;
  - Annex IX Point I.B.8 to Council Regulation (EU) N°267/2012 as it continues to affect directly Sina Bank as stated in the Notice of 15 March 2014.
2. The Applicant relies upon the following grounds in support of his claim:
  - breach of the rights of defence and the right to effective judicial protection; and
  - manifest error of assessment.

3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Mr Bart DRIESSEN and Ms Delyana GICHEVA, members of the Legal Service, as the Council's agents in Case T-418/14.
