- Case T-486/14 (Edward Stavytskyi v. Council)

---

1. By an application notified to the Council on 16 July 2014, Edward Stavytskyi has brought an action pursuant to Article 263 TFEU to annul Council Implementing Decision 2014/216/CFSP of 14 April 2014, implementing Decision 2014/119/CFSP concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies in view of the situation in Ukraine, and Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 381/2014 of 14 April 2014, implementing Regulation (EU) No 208/2014 concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies in view of the situation in Ukraine, insofar as they apply to the applicant.
2. The applicant submits six grounds of challenge:
  - violation of the right of hearing;
  - violation of the obligation to give notice;

- insufficient statement of reasons;
  - violation of the right of defence;
  - incorrect legal basis;
  - manifest error of assessment.
3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Mr Vincent PIESSEVAUX and Mr Jan-Peter HIX, members of the Legal Service, as the Council’s agents in this case.
