Subject:	Draft Commission Regulation (EU) No/ of XXX implementing Regulation (EC) No 1177/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning Community statistics on income and living conditions (EU-SILC) as regards the 2015 list of target secondary variables on social and cultural participation and material deprivation

 On 27 September 2013, the Statistical Programme Committee gave a favourable opinion on draft Commission Regulation (EU) No .../.. of XXX implementing Regulation (EC) No 1177/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning Community statistics on income and living conditions (EU-SILC) as regards the 2015 list of target secondary variables on social and cultural participation and material deprivation.

- In accordance with the procedure in Article 5a(3) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC¹, the Commission therefore submitted the draft measure to the Council for scrutiny² on 1 October 2013.
- 3. The Working Party on Statistics considered the draft measure in a written procedure and agreed not to oppose it. The Commission has been informed that in the course of the written procedure, <u>the Czech delegation</u> indicated its intention to submit linguistic comments, in order for it to make the necessary modifications to the CZ version of the text before the final adoption of the Commission Regulation.
- 4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to:
 - confirm the agreement reached in the Working Party, and
 - ask the Council not to oppose the draft measure proposed by the Commission.
