Subject: Case before the General Court:
- Case T-381/14 (Viktor Pavlovych Pshonka v. Council)

1. By application notified to the Council on 3 July 2014, Viktor Pavlovych Pshonka has brought an action pursuant to Article 263 TFEU to partially annul Council Decision 2014/119/CFSP of 5 March 2014 and Council Regulation No 208/2014 of 5 March 2014 both concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies in view of the situation in Ukraine, insofar as they apply to the Applicant.
2. The applicant invokes the following grounds in support of his application:
 - a) lack of competence of the Council and encroachment of the natural judge's competences;
 - b) obvious error in the assessment of the facts;
 - c) violations of the applicant's fundamental rights.
3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Mr Vincent PIESSEVAUX and Mr Alessandro VITRO, legal advisors in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
