Subject:	Case before the General Court:
	- Case T-380/14 (Artem Viktorovych Pshonka v. Council)

- By application notified to the Council on 4 July 2014, Artem Viktorovych Pshonka has brought an action pursuant to Article 263 TFEU to partially annul Council Decision 2014/119/CFSP of 5 March 2014 and Council Regulation No 208/2014 of 5 March 2014 both concerning restrictive measures directed against certain persons, entities and bodies in view of the situation in Ukraine, insofar as they apply to the Applicant.
- 2. The applicant invokes the following grounds in support of his application:
  - a) lack of competence of the Council and encroachment of the natural judge's competences;
  - b) obvious error in the assessment of the facts;
  - c) violations of the applicant's fundamental rights.
- 3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Mr Vincent PIESSEVAUX and Mr Alessandro VITRO, legal advisors in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
