Subject: The role of the law enforcement training in the implementation of the Internal Security Strategy

The Presidency attaches great importance to the subject of law enforcement training. Following on from the discussion held under the EL Presidency at the LEWP on 25 June 2014 about the Commission's Communication on the Law Enforcement Training Scheme (LETS)¹ and against the background of draft new CEPOL Regulation², the Presidency wishes to stimulate a debate among Member States on the role of training to ensure an effective implementation of the fundamental objectives of the Internal Security Strategy (ISS). This can be an element in the discussions about the review of the Internal Security Strategy that have started recently³.

To this end, delegations are invited to discuss the following issues:

1. What role can law enforcement training play in the implementation of the Internal Security Strategy? How can the Member States' law enforcement training programmes reflect the ISS' fundamental contents and approaches?
